Sunrise Sour

Dave Arnold's Glo Sour is fantastic, why screw with it you ask? "Why not? Don't judge me." This is a Old Man Ski twist on that turmeric infused modern classic. Sunrise in a coop glass.

Whiskey

Smoked Old Fashioned
